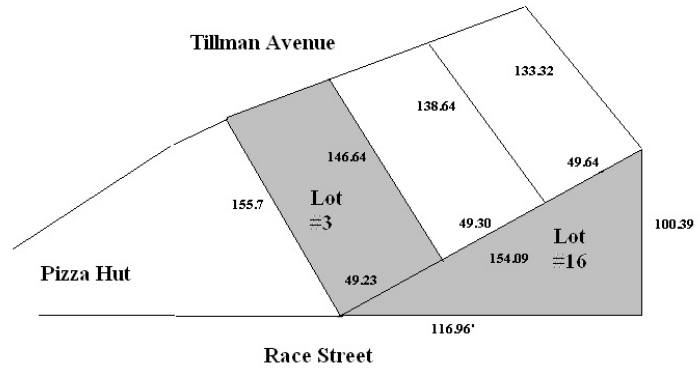
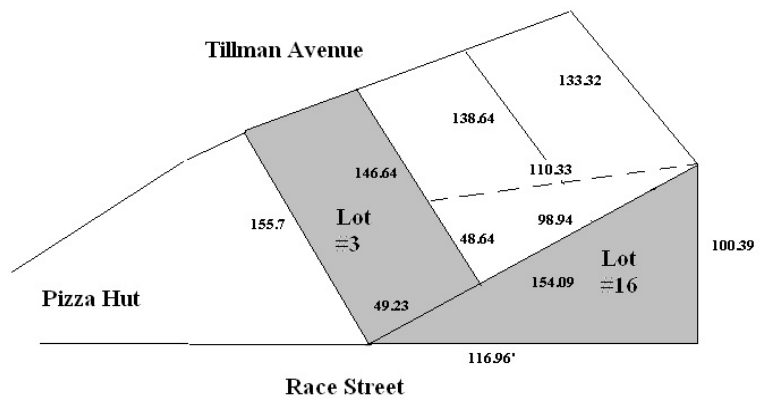


How the lot at 153 Race Street was created

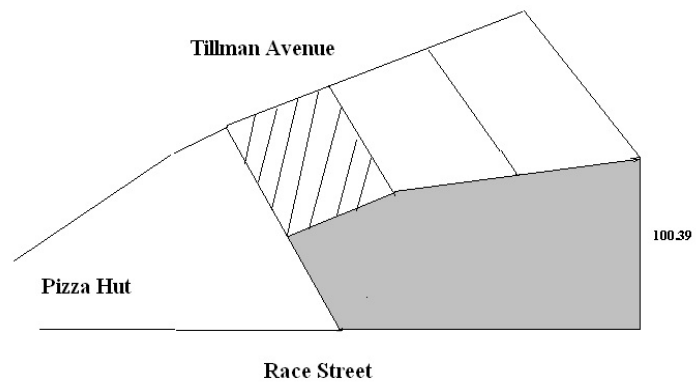
In February of 1922, Antonio Parisi bought two lots (#3 and #16) from Peninsula Land & Improvement, configured like this:



He had already started building the first house, and in February of 1923, he purchased land from his neighbor:



With this parcel of land, he had a lot that looked like this:



The other part of Lot #3 was still his, but it is unknown whether he built the house that stands there, or he sold it and someone else built that house.

At some later date, the lot was split, either by Parisi himself or by the Bank of Italy (after Parisi lost the house for failure to make payments).
